RANGE LOCATION:

WMRPC is located on Lincoln Road, 1 mile west of Ionia. Take Exit 67 off I96, go north on M66 to M21, about 7 miles. Turn left (west) on M21 and go approximately 1 mile. Lincoln Road is a blacktop road going to the right as M21 begins to curve to the south. Go west on Lincoln Rd approximately 1.2 miles to the range. If coming from the north, take M66 south to M21 and turn right. Continue west on M21 approximately 1 mile to Lincoln Rd. and follow the above directions. 2116 W Lincoln, Ionia MI 48846

Facilities: 32 paved and covered firing points. Electronically controlled sustained fire targets. Restrooms and eating area in clubhouse.

TRANSPORTATION: The club has arranged for transportation between the 50-yard line and the 25-yard line.

CLASSIFICATION/CATEGORY:

The current NRA classification system will be used. Open to anyone meeting the eligibility requirements specified under NRA and CMP rules. Classification cards or temporary score books must be shown. This tournament will be categorized: Service and Civilian. Regular service, Reserve, National Guard, and Police will compete in the Service category. All others will compete in the civilian category. If there are less than five (5) in a category, categories will be combined.

EIC .45 and .22 LEG match and Revolver match entry may be made at the range,

Entries will be limited to 32 competitors. SHOOT THE WORKS entries will be given preference. Advance entries for all matches are preferred, so squadding can be completed. Post entries will be accepted to the capacity of the range. IF YOU REGISTER AND CAN NOT SHOOT, PLEASE NOTIFY THE STATISTICAL OFFICER SO OTHERS MAY BE SQUADED.

Registration/Check in begins at 9:00 AM. Firing will begin at 10:00 AM each day. Saturday will consist of .22 and CF. Sunday will be .45 and "Distinguished" relays.

"Distinguished" relays for .22 EIC, .45 and NRA Revolver will begin after Individual .45 match has completed on Sunday, competitors can choose to shoot either CMP EIC, or NRA Distinguished Revolver for each relay. Space permitting, a shooter may shoot in both "Distinguished" Relays – *shooters entering both relays for the same discipline(EIC or Revolver) will have their first Relay score officially recorded, the score from the second Relay will be considered paid practice**.

AMMUNITION for ALL Matches MUST BE SUPPLIED BY THE COMPETITOR.

SHOOT THE WORKS \$50.00, includes lunch both days

If not registering for "Shoot the works" NRA Registration fee \$8.00

MATCH FEES: \$3.00 per match; .

.45 EIC(LEG) MATCH: \$15.00 Competitors must furnish their own ammunition.

.22 EIC(LEG) MATCH: \$15.00 Competitors must furnish their own ammunition.

Distinguished Revolver \$15.00 Competitors must furnish their own ammunition

RULES:

Matches are governed by NRA rules, or CMP rules for Hard ball "Leg" match. **All competitors must wear eye and ear protection.** The jury system will be used to decide challenges if no referee is assigned by the NRA.

The challenge fee is \$3.00. If a challenge is sustained the fee will be returned. Competitors will score the target to their left. Bring your stapler.

All Slow Fire will be fired on the NRA approved B6 targets; all Timed and Rapid Fire will be fired on the NRA approved B8 target.

Protests must be filed in accordance with Rule 16.3.

Distinguished .22(only) Relay (Sunday):

30 shots NMC Distinguished Pistol((Leg)CMP rules apply)

Distinguished Relay 1(Sunday):

30 shots NMC Distinguished Pistol((Leg)CMP rules apply) Or Distinguished Revolver(NRA Rules apply)

Distinguished Relay 2(Sunday): following COMPLETION of Relay 1

30 shots NMC Distinguished Pistol((Leg)CMP rules apply) Or Distinguished Revolver(NRA Rules apply)*

**See above rules regarding participation in both relays*

NRA Rule: In order to shoot the Distinguished Revolver match, the competitor MUST shoot the Regional Championship.

AWARDS:

There will be a winner in each match. In each class and category with 5-10 competitors a first place will be awarded. With 11-20, second place and third with 21-30. If there are less than 5 High Masters, they will compete for match winner only. Cash will be the only award available.
