Who may compete:

Open to anyone who meets the eligibility requirements specified under NRA and CMP rules. Competitor must be a resident of Michigan and a member of the Michigan Rifle and Pistol Association in order to be declared the State Service Pistol Champion. **MRPA requires that adult non-members be charged a \$10 fee for the event and that the sponsors remit said fees to the MRPA Secretary/Treasurer.** Membership forms available at the range.

Range Location: WMRPC 2116 W. Lincoln Ave. Ionia 48846. Take M21 west from Ionia. Turn right on Lincoln. Range is on the right (north) in about 1.2 miles. Phone 616 527 4464.

Service Pistol C'ship entries Limited to 32 competitors.

Facilities: 32 paved and covered firing points. Electronically controlled sustained fire targets. Restrooms and eating area in clubhouse.

Registration starts at 900. The Service Pistol Championship starts at **1000.** The CMP Service Pistol EIC Match and the NRA Distinguished Revolver Match relays will follow the Championship after a short break. The CMP 22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match will be fired after all other firing is completed.

Categories/Classes: (Service Pistol C'ship only)

Competitors will be divided into two categories: Civilian and Service. Service will include Regular, Reserve, National Guard and Police. With fewer than five competitors in a category, the categories will be combined within the same class. Each match will have a Match Winner. In each class and category with 5 – 10 competitors, excluding Match Winner, there will be a first in class/category winner. With 11 – 20 competitors, a second in class/category will be awarded. Match Winners will not be eligible for any class award in the same match. A competitor will not be eligible for more than one award per match. In the event of fewer than five Master or High Master competitors, only match winner will be paid.

Awards:

Service Pistol C'ship. Awards for all matches will be cash, based on the NRA point system. \$1 per point will be mailed. The highest scoring competitor in Match 5 who is a Michigan resident and a member of MRPA will be declared the Michigan Service Pistol Champion and will be given possession of the Service Pistol Champion Trophy until the next Michigan State Service Pistol Championship.

CMP EIC Matches. Credit toward distinguished and/or "Excellence-in-Competition" Badges in accordance with CMP rules.

NRA Distinguished Revolver. Credit toward Distinguished Revolver certification according to NRA rules.

Course of Fire:

Service Pistol Championship

Match 1: 20 Shots Slow fire @ 50 yds. (B6)

Match 2 (NMC): 10 Shots Slow fire @ 50 yds. (B6)

10 Shots Timed fire @ 25 yds. (B8)

10 Shots Rapid fire @ 25 yds. (B8)

Match 3: 20 Shots Timed fire @ 25 yds. (B8)

Match 4: 20 Shots Rapid Fire @ 25 yds. (B8)

Match 5: Aggregate of Matches 1 – 4.

CMP EIC Matches and NRA Distinguished Revolver Match

First stage: 10 Shots Slow fire @ 50 yds. (B6)

Second stage: 10 Shots Timed fire @ 25 yds. (B8)

Third stage: 10 Shots Rapid fire @ 25 yds. (B8).

Approved Firearms:

State Service Pistol Championship and CMP Service Pistol EIC Match: NRA rules 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 and CMP rule 6.3.

CMP 22 Rimfire EIC Match: CMP rule 6.4.

NRA Distinguished Revolver Match: NRA rule 3.1.4

Approved Ammunition:

State Service Pistol Championship, CMP Service Pistol EIC Match and CMP 22 Rimfire Pistol EIC: CMP rule 6.6.2.

NRA Distinguished Revolver Match: NRA rule 3.1.4 (e).

Notes:

NRA and CMP rules apply as applicable. Eye and ear protection required. Challenge fee is \$2. If no referee, jury system will be used. All events will be squadded. A light meal will be served after the championship match.
